A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Clumber Spaniel, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Chinese Shar-Pei, Keeshonden, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc).

At the discretion of the judge the following breed may be judged on the table or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Cardigan Welsh Corgis.

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Basset Hounds, Bulldogs and Chow Chows. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation doing shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW GROUNDS

From North & South Via Interstate 295: Take 295 to Exit 65A, Sloane Avenue. East on Sloane Avenue to Second traffic light, Quaker Bridge Road. Cross over Quaker Bridge Road and go to next traffic light (road makes a T) and make a left onto Edinburg Road (Route 535). The name of the road changes to Old Trenton Road. Continue for about 2 miles with Mercer County Park ENTRANCE on the left.

From North Via U.S. 1: Take US 1 South of Princeton to Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Bear Right off US 1 onto jughandle to cross over US 1 onto Rt. 533, Quaker Bridge Road. Go to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Route 535, Edinburg Road. Travel 2 miles to Mercer County Park.

From South Via U.S. Route 1: Cross toll bridge into New Jersey. On U.S. 1 make first right past Quaker Bridge Mall onto Quaker Bridge Road (Route 533). Go to the 6th traffic light and turn left onto Hughes Drive. At the first traffic light turn left onto Route 535, Edinburg Road. Travel 2 miles to Mercer County Park ENTRANCE on the left.

From North (Route 130 South) or NJ Turnpike Exit 8 A: Exit 8A toward Rt. 130 South. Go to the 6th light on Route 130 South and turn right onto Old Trenton Road (Rt. 535). Go through 6 traffic lights and Mercer County Park ENTRANCE is on the right.

From South Via NJ Route 130/206: Follow Route 130 North to Route 526 in Robbinsville and turn left on to Route 526. (Corners: Costal Delta Station, Russert's Deli, Taco Bell). Turn right at the next traffic light; you are still on Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. From this point travel 3 miles to Route 535, Old Trenton Road and turn left. The exhibitors's ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile ahead on the right.

From South Via New Jersey Turnpike: Take NJ Turnpike North to Exit 7A. Take Interstate 195 West to Exit 5B which is the first exit on Route 195 To Route 139 North/New Brunswick. Travel North on Route 130 to second traffic light and turn left onto Route 526. Proceed to the next traffic light and right onto Route 526 with Rite Aide on your right. Go 3 miles to Route 526, Old Trenton Road. Mercer County Park ENTRANCE is 1/3 mile on the right.

The above classes are provided in all breeds and in each breed variety. Where certain classes are divided by age, color, or weight, it is so noted in List of Breeds and MUST BE INDICATED ON ENTRY FORM.

*West Highland White Terrier Classes will be 6-9; 9-12; 12-15 & 15-18 months. (Sunday Only)

Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

- All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be **individually registered** with the AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Non-Regular Classes-Involving Single Dog Entries (Spayed Bitches or Neutered Dogs CANNOT be entered)

SUNDAY ONLY - Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) years old or older except for the following exceptions on ages:

SUNDAY ONLY - Veteran Classes - CHESAPEAKE BAY RETRIEVERS ONLY

Class for dogs & class for bitches 8 YEARS OR OLDER.

SUNDAY ONLY - Veteran Classes - GOLDEN RETRIEVERS ONLY

Class for dogs & class for bitches 8-10; 10-12; 12 & over.

SUNDAY ONLY - Veteran Classes - ENGLISH SPRINGER SPANIELS ONLY

Class for dogs & class for bitches 7-9; 9-11; 11 & over.

SUNDAY & MONDAY - Veteran Classes - MASTIFFS ONLY

Class for dogs & class for bitches 6-9; 9 years old and older.

Best of Breed/Variety Competition

Non-Regular Classes-Involving Multiple Dog Entries - Stud Dog Class - Where indicated -

Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. Fee is \$30.00 for the Stud Dog if not entered in another class; \$26.00 as an additional class.

Brood Bitch Class - Where indicated - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won this class.

Brace Class - (two dogs of the same breed or variety and must have at least one common owner and represented by a maximum of two handlers) - Where indicated - \$30.00 for the Brace as a UNIT. \$26.00 as an additional class. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of the entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms.

An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class".

If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1" "Brace No. 2" etc.

Owner-Handled Series
Sunday, May 7, 2017
Monday, May 8, 2017

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners who are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at dog shows across the country.

All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers' meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.**

The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the owner sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners Competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.*

BEGINNER PUPPY SPECIAL ATTRACTION

DATE - May 7-8, 2017

**Bring your Beginner Puppies (4-6 months of age) to the Trenton Kennel Club
Four to Six Month Special Attraction (AKC Sanctioned).**

One combined class will be offered for breeds and varieties of dogs that are four months and under six months and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. There will be a selection of Best of Breed Puppy in each Breed/Variety. All Best of Breed Puppy winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth.

The Miscellaneous class competition will be judged by breed followed by a group competition. Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds may compete and the winners of each FSS breed will compete in an "FSS Group". The Miscellaneous Group and FSS Group winners will be eligible to compete in Best 4-6 Month Puppy in Show. An AKC registration number or litter number is required for entries of an AKC recognized breed. FSS number or FSS registered litter number is required for Miscellaneous & FSS Breed entries.

The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent to be advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

Effective May 1, 2006 an administrative fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
